1. On Lifestyle and consumption of goods
  - a. Consume what is enough (i.e, food, water)
  - b. Use of eco-friendly products (i.e, clothing apparels)
  - c. Less meat, no Soda, less junk food diet
2. On plastic use and waste management
  - a. Zero-plastic approach in all SCA activities
  - b. Promotion of 4 Rs (Reuse, Reduce, Refuse, Recycle)
3. On energy consumption
  - a. Car-pooling and use of public transport
